### DAY 0 - 30 APRIL

#### **Departure from Bucharest**

 Our trip kicks off with our flight from Henri Coanda International Airport at 17:30. To ensure a smooth start, please plan to arrive at the airport by 15:00.



### DAY I - MAY I

#### **Arrival in Hanoi**

- 14:00: Arrival in Hanoi. A bus will transport us from the airport to our hotel in the Old Quarter, a charming neighborhood that encapsulates the essence of Vietnamese culture. Our hotel is close to all the main sights, with plenty of restaurants and coffee shops nearby.
- At first, Hanoi might feel a bit overwhelming, but don't worry. After a refreshing shower and some rest, we'll be fully recharged and ready to dive into our adventure.
- Late Afternoon: Visit the nearest store to buy SIM cards and

exchange local currency, followed by a group dinner at a local restaurant.

 Evening: Walk around St. Joseph's Cathedral and Hoàn Kiếm Lake, and optionally we can have some drinks at a bar nearby.



### DAY 2 - MAY 2

#### **Exploring Hanoi**

- Morning: Breakfast at Puku restaurant.
- 9:30: We visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, which is the final resting place of Vietnam's revered leader Ho Chi Minh and an iconic symbol of the country's history.
- After Prison Visit: the infamous Hoa Lo Prison, which offers insights into Vietnam's tumultuous history.
- Afternoon: Lunch and of course, egg coffee at one of our favorite coffee shops.

### 18:00: We gather to watch the Hanoi train pass. While it's a popular tourist attraction, it remains a distinct local experience.

• Dinner: Traditional Vietnamese group dinner.



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### DAY 3 - MAY 3

#### **Transition to Ninh Binh**

- Morning: The morning schedule is flexible, allowing you to enjoy breakfast at Puku at your convenience, visit your favorite coffee shop, or look for souvenirs. Check out the Mapstr profile for the best coffee shops in town.
- Afternoon: Lunch and then bus trip to Ninh Binh, a place that is renowned for its warm hospitality.
- Sunset: Upon arrival, we'll head straight to Mua Cave viewpoint to catch the breathtaking sunset.

Bicycles will be our primary mode of transport here, offering an easy and safe way to explore. For those who cannot ride a bicycle, don't worry! We can offer free lessons :D Alternatively, you can jump on our motorbike, which we always carry around for safety and convenience.



### DAY 4 - MAY 4

#### Let's discover Ninh Binh: Trang An Day Trip

- Morning: Breakfast, followed by a 15km bicycle journey to Trang An for an exciting boat trip. It might seem long, but we take our time. It's also the best way to explore the beautiful country roads of Ninh Binh. We're heading for a stunning place where we can experience an amazing 3-hour boat trip between the mountains of Trang An, and through caves that are up to 1km long. Don't forget sunscreen and your nón lá to protect you from the sun.
- We'll have lunch together, and once everyone is safely accounted for, you'll have some time to explore the

surroundings on your own. However, our trip to Trang An will take most of the day, leaving you just enough time to rest or relax by the swimming pool before dinner.



### DAY 5 - MAY 5

#### **Bird Valley**

- We'll have breakfast at the accommodation before heading out on our bicycles to visit the scenic Bird Valley in Tam Coc, known for its lush landscapes and vibrant birdlife.
